The Township of North Dumfries Engineering and Public Works department is inviting members of the public to review construction plans and receive input from interested persons. Owners and tenants of properties within the construction limits and on adjacent streets may be particularly interested in attending. We welcome any comments or feedback from residents and businesses within the construction limits, and on adjacent streets to the proposed projects. RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Inglis Street, Northumberland Street to Colquhoun Street (approximately 365m)

- Remove the existing asphalt surface, grade, reshape and compact the road bed to restore a centreline and specified or existing crossfall.
- Lay 50 mm HL4 base course of asphalt with a 50 mm HL3 surface layer of asphalt
- Construct approximately 107m of curb.
- Remove island on Inglis Street at intersection with Elliot Street and realign Elliot Street
- Construct five (5) infiltration trenches 1.5m in depth.
- Installation of 6 storm structures and approximately 93m of storm sewer (between 200mm to 250mm)
