## Regional and Educational Development Charges

The Region of Waterloo and the two school boards are also eligible to levy development charges to offset costs attributed to residential and non-residential growth. The Township collects these funds on behalf of the agencies when the building permit is approved and then transfers the funds collected on a monthly basis. The charges for the Region of Waterloo and the Separate and Public School boards are not reflected in this brochure.

#### What are Development Charges?

Development charges are imposed by municipalities to pay for increased capital costs related to growth. Development charges provide municipalities with a tool for the recovery of growth-related capital expenditures from new development. These include capital costs related to public works, fire protection, outdoor/indoor recreation and administration services.

### When is the Development Charge paid to the Township?

The development charge is paid to the Township when the building permit application is approved and the permit is issued.

### Township of North Dumfries Development Charges

The Township of North Dumfries Council passed the Development Charges Bylaw number 3208-20 effective January 1, 2021 under Subsection 2(1) of the Development Charges Act, 1997.

Each December 1<sup>st</sup>, the Township of North Dumfries adjusts the development charges payable to account for inflationary factors. The rates imposed under the development charges by-law are required to pay for the increased capital costs related to the provision of services related to a highway, fire protection services, parks and recreation and growth-related studies. These expenditures are combined in the Township charges.
