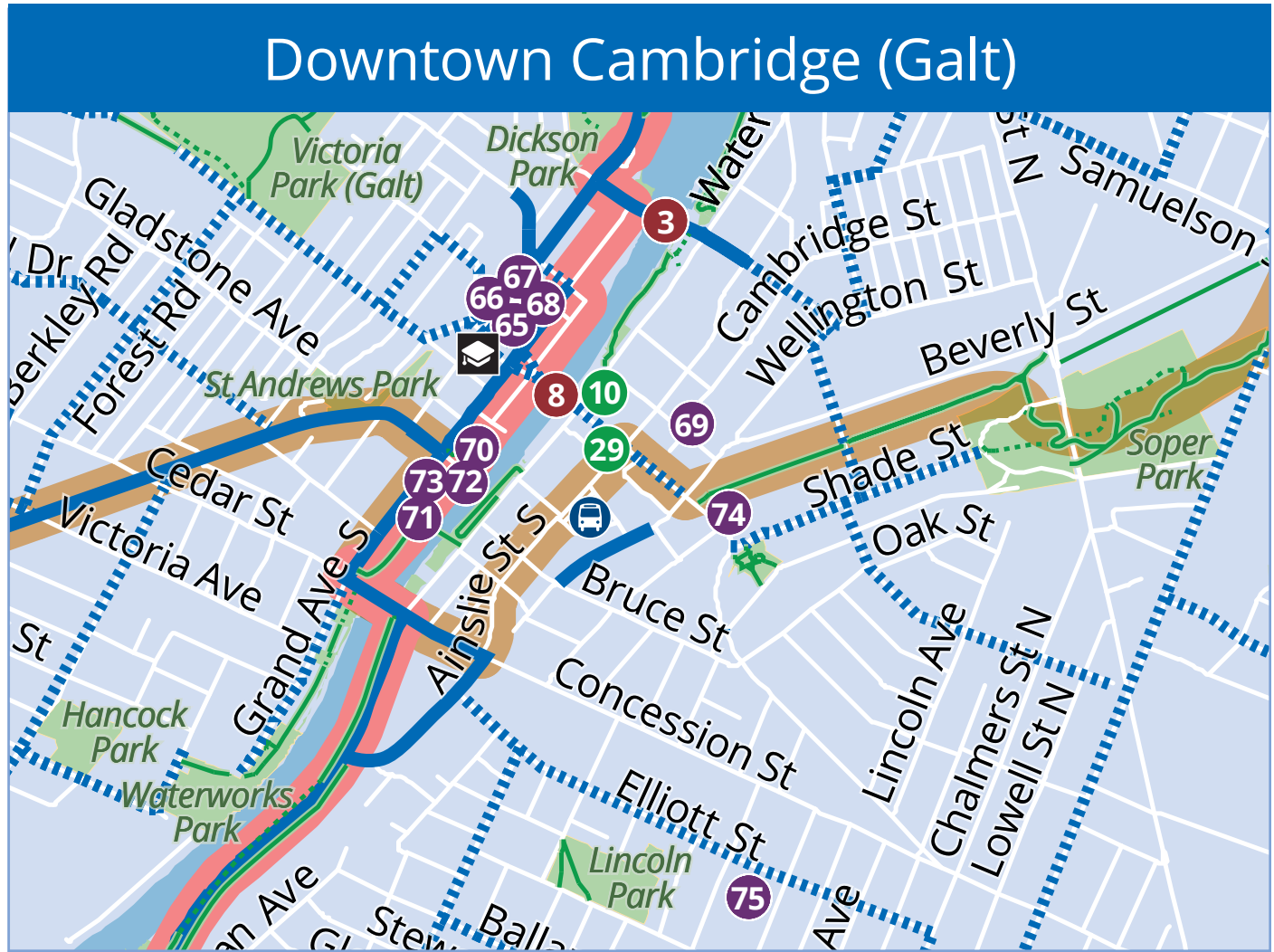
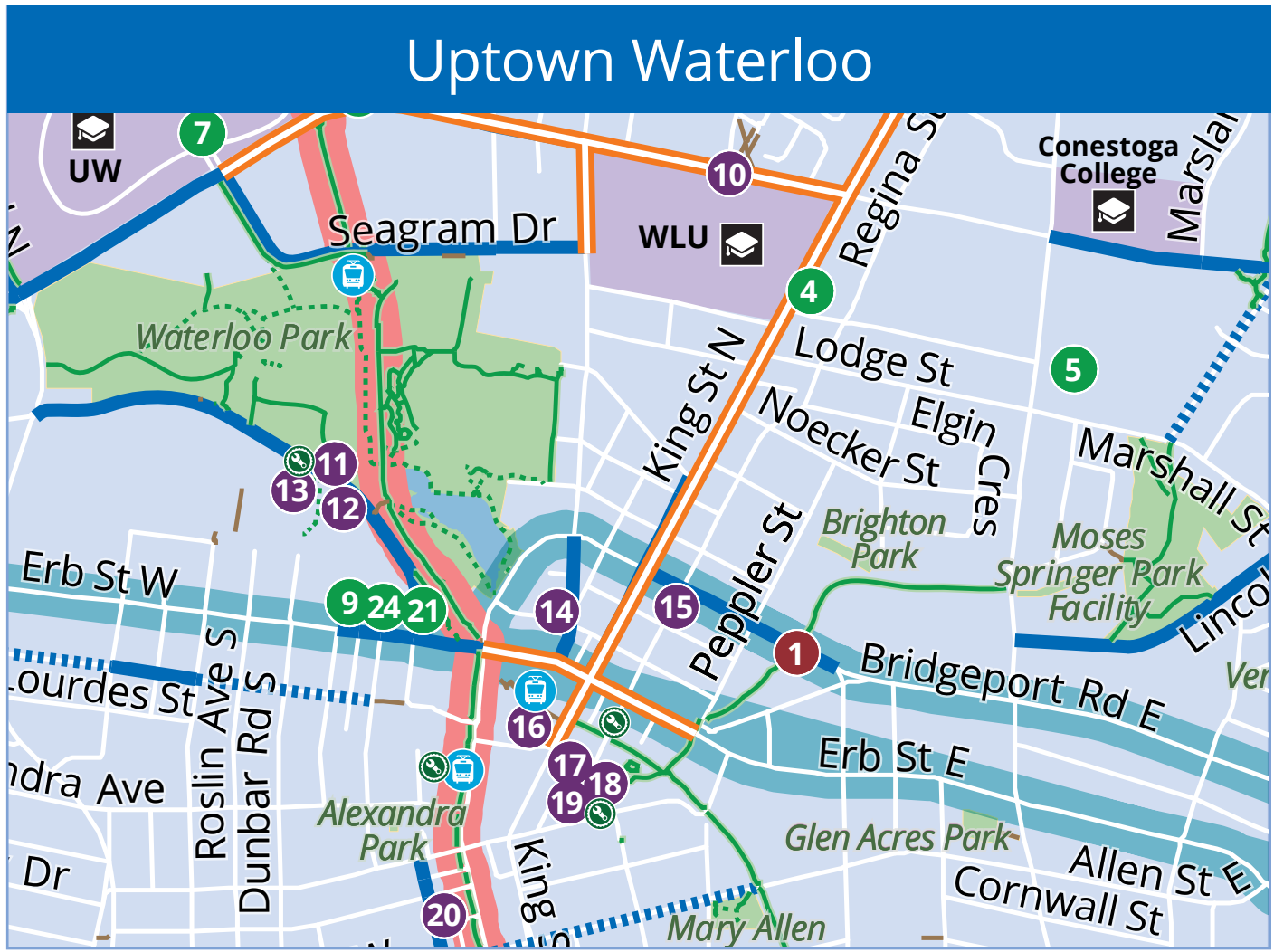
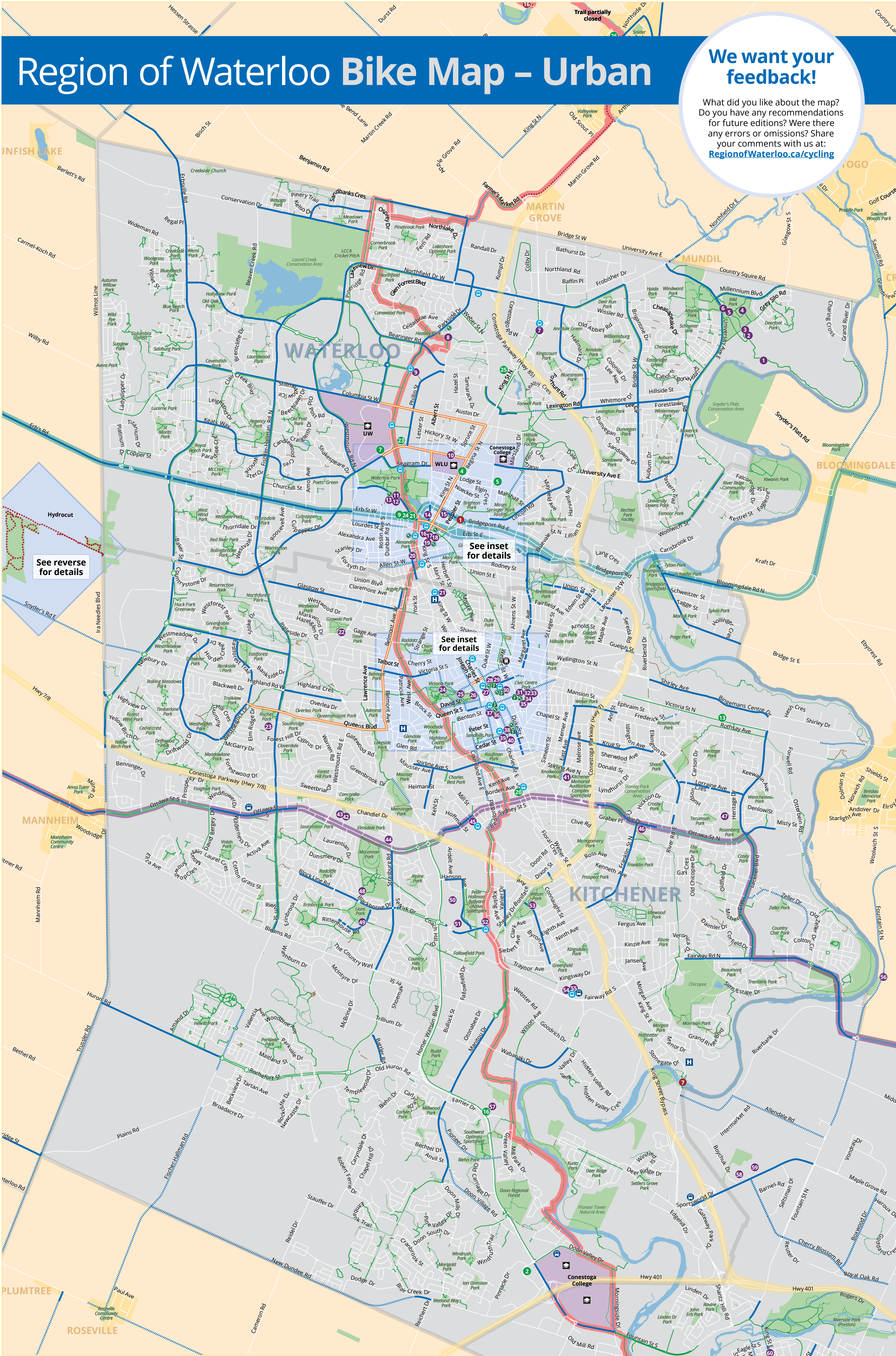

Bike to Ontario's largest community museum

16 The Ken Seiling Waterloo Region Museum is the largest community museum in Ontario with two indoor galleries and a 60 acre living history exhibit called Doon Heritage Village that is open seasonally from May 1 to December 23. The main gallery tells the story of Waterloo Region from 12,000 years ago to today, and the feature gallery showcases local exhibits and travelling exhibits from around the world.

In 2020, the museum was named "Best Bicycle Friendly Business" by Ontario By Bike for providing services and welcoming cyclists visiting their location. The Ken Seiling Waterloo Region Museum is located next to a new paved trail along Homer Watson Boulevard.

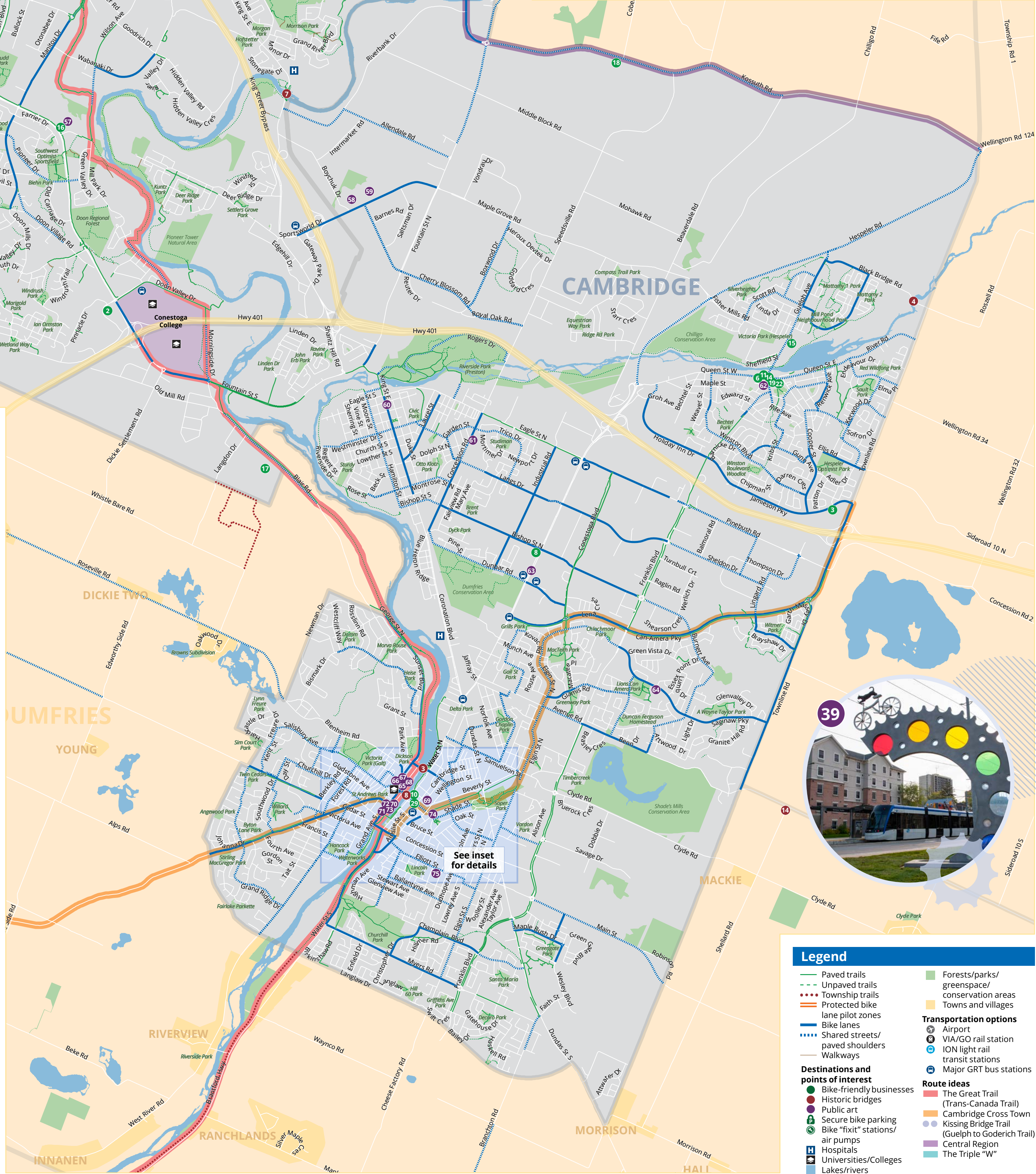
